A tin mine in the past, it got its name from Liwong Mining Co. Ltd. And began mining in 1978. The land was originally bought from villagers by Mr. Pramote Piyatham and Mr. Wiwat Wattanayondakij. Now, the Liwong Tin Mine bought over by Mr Kiee Jiranakorn is being developed into a new tourist attraction in Hat yai.







Since its mining days from 1978, Liwong mine located in Chana District, Songkhla was an abundant source of tin ore with mountain surrounding it. Mining days over, the mine is now a man-made lake with clear emerald green waters.

Surrounded by large pine trees, Liwong Mine has become a camera worthy photo spot and is a trademark picture to catch there.


